

ONLINE ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. The candidate can get the Prospectus-cum-Handbook of Information online at: <https://gdcnerwa.edu.in> or <https://gdcnerwa.highaltdeducation.in>.
2. A fee of Rs. 50/- will be charged for the online registration and downloading prospectus.
3. The candidate seeking admission to 1st year has to apply on the prescribed form available online at: <https://gdcnerwa.highaltdeducation.in> or [**https://gdcnerwa.edu.in**](https://gdcnerwa.edu.in)
4. Students can visit the college office or contact on phone the College Admission cum Counseling & Guidance Committee during college hours, if they face any difficulty in filling up the admission form.
5. The merit list will be displayed as per the schedule mentioned in the prospectus.
6. After getting the admission form approved, applicants are advised to deposit their fees online within the due date.

Note

- No admission request will be entertained after the expiry of the last date of admission.
- No such candidate will be admitted to the college whose conduct is not found satisfactory in the previous year.
- The student, who is rusticated or expelled, will not be given admission to any recognized college without the permission of the vice-chancellor.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

(B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. First Year)

1. A pass certificate in the Senior Secondary (+2) Examination (Academic Stream), conducted by the H.P. Board of School Education or an examination accepted as equivalent by the bodies of the H.P. University.
2. Candidates must have secured at least 33% at 10+2 level to get admission to B.A. course.
3. Candidates must have secured at least 45% at 10+2 level to get admission to B.Com. & B.Sc. course. However for female candidates and students belonging to SC/ST category, the required percentage stands restricted to 40% for admission in B.Com. & B.Sc. course.
4. Those candidates who haven't studied Commerce subjects at 10+2 level and still want to seek admission to B.Com. must have studied Mathematics/ Economics as compulsory subjects with 45% to be considered for admission to B.Com. course
5. An applicant failing in all subjects or having received compartment in 10+2 will not be admitted.
6. Admissions will be based on merit, as the seats are limited in all faculties.
7. The reservation of seats will be according to the H.P. University's reservation roster.

AGE LIMIT FOR UNDERGRADUATE COURSES

1. The upper age Limit for admission to BA/B.Com. /B.Sc. first year is 23 for Boys and 25 for Girls as on 1st July, 2024.
2. Age relaxation of 3 years is allowed for SC/ST candidates.
3. The Vice-Chancellor of Himachal Pradesh University can allow age relaxation up to a maximum period of 3 months in special cases.

1. Master of Arts in English (M.A. English)
2. Master of Arts in Political Science (M.A. Political Science)
3. Master of Commerce (M.Com.)

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR P.G. COURSES

The admission in all PG courses will be made on the basis of marks obtained in the entrance test conducted by Himachal Pradesh University Shimla. All the candidates seeking admission to M.A /M. Com. at G.C Nerwa, will have to apply to Himachal Pradesh University Shimla for the entrance test as per HPU schedule. After the declaration of result of entrance test by HPU, the applicants must apply to the college for admission and present themselves for the verification of original documents on the counselling date and time fixed by the college. The list of selected candidates will be displayed on the college notice board/website. Selected candidates will have to deposit their dues within the notified time, failing which the admission will stand cancelled and the vacant seats will be allotted to the next candidates in the merit list.

Eligibility for M. A. (English, Political Science) & M. Com.

Bachelor degree with **48 credits** in the subject concerned

AGE LIMIT FOR P.G. COURSES

1. The upper age Limit for admission to MA & M.Com. first semester is 26 years for male and 28 years for female candidates as on 1st July, 2024.
2. Age relaxation of 3 years is allowed for SC/ST candidates.
3. The Vice-Chancellor of Himachal Pradesh University can allow age relaxation up to a maximum period of 3 months in special cases.

UNIVERSITY REGISTRATION

Fresh students must get themselves registered with HP University. For this attested copies of matriculation and 10+2 certificates are required. Each student will be issued a registration number by the university and no result will be declared without the university registration number.
